## Stakeholders come together for best practices on millet

## Bhubaneswar, 09/11/2023:

Stakeholders from India and other countries came together to share best practices and learnings about the implementation of millet missions and programs here in a session. Organised by Department of Agriculture and Farmers' Empowerment of the Government of Odisha on the eve of International Convention on Millets to celebrate International Year of Millets 2023, the session developed a roadmap for millets for coming decade.

The session was attended by representatives from the Department of Agriculture and Farmers' Empowerment, millet ambassadors from various nations, Officials from the United Nations World Food Programme (WFP) in India. Ms. Nozomi Hashimoto, Deputy Country Director of WFP in India and Ms Shubha Thakur, Joint Secretary, GoI jointly chaired teh session. The session was guided by Sri Prem Chandra Chaudhary, Director, Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha.

The participants shared their best practices and discussed how they can collaborate to promote millets. The participants emphasized the need for a platform that can engage different stakeholders, particularly those from India/Asia and Middle East.
