Sub: REVISED-District-wise **tri-monthly** State Allotment Order of food grains (**Fortified Rice & Wheat**) for PHH and AAY families under NFSA (Regular Allocation) for the month of **October-November-December 2024**.

Madam/Sir,

In pursuance of Letter No. 1-8/2013-BP.III(Vol.II)Pt Dated 24th September 2024 and in supersession to this Department State Allotment Order No. 12955 Dated 30th August 2024, I am directed to communicate the district-wise **revised allocation** of **49,62,008.76 quintals of Fortified Rice and 5,94,945.75 quintals of Wheat** from Central Pool for distribution among the Priority Households (PHH) and Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) households, under NFSA (PMGKAY), for the month of **October-November-December 2024**, as per enclosed **Annexure-I**.

As per the provision of NFSA (PMGKAY), the PHH beneficiaries are entitled to get **5 (Five) Kgs** of rice, wheat or combination of both as per the option exercised by the PHH beneficiaries subject to quantity of wheat allotment received from Government of India, per person per month at **free of cost**. The AAY beneficiaries will continue to get **35 Kgs** of rice per household per month at **free of cost**.

All other terms and conditions communicated vide this Department State Allotment Order No. 12955 Dated 30th August 2024 remain the same except the following:
