Super Specialty OPD treatment inaugurated at Employees State Insurance (ESI) Hospital, Bhubaneswar

Employees State Insurance Scheme is a multi-faceted health insurance and social security scheme under which social security is provided to employees in the organized sector. The insured employees and their dependent family members also get this insurance service. This scheme has been implemented in Odisha since 1960. Currently, this scheme is providing treatment to about 10 lakh insured employees through 4 hospitals and 53 dispensaries in Odisha. In addition, there is a proposal to open 5 more new hospitals. The main objective of Employees State Insurance Scheme is to provide complete medical services to the beneficiaries.

In the current situation, kidney, heart diseases etc. are on the rise. For this, agreements have been made with 12 Secondary Care and 15 Tertiary Care for better treatment of the beneficiaries. Agreements are being made with Secondary Care at each district level soon to provide more medical services to the insured employees. Recently, for the first time, a Dialysis Unit has been opened in the Employees State Insurance (ESI) Hospital in Bhubaneswar.

For the convenience of these insured employees, Minister of Labour and Employees State Insurance, Forest, Environment and Climate Change depts Shri Ganesh Ram Singkhuntia inaugurated the Super Specialty OPD treatment at the ESI Hospital, Bhubaneswar today. This service will be implemented in partnership with Hi-Tech Medical College and Hospital, Bhubaneswar. It has the facilities of highly specialized treatment like Urology, Cardiology, Oncology, Neurosurgery, Nephrology, Neurology and Endocrinology.

This service is also available free of cost to the insured employees and their family members. The State Government is committed to providing all medical facilities to the insured employees without any hindrance.



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
