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NHRC to Hold Camp sitting / Open Hearing in Bhubaneswar on 21st-22nd July, 2025

144 Human Rights Cases to be Heard

The National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) will conduct a two-day Camp Sitting at the State Guest House in Bhubaneswar on July 21 and 22, 2025, to address key human rights issues in the State of Odisha. During this special session, two Benches of the Commission are expected to hear 144 pending cases on the spot, with the direct involvement of complainants and victims.

The Hon'ble Chairperson of the NHRC, accompanied by three Members, senior officials, will attend the Camp Sitting. The visit underscores the Commission's commitment to resolving human rights complaints swiftly and ensuring better coordination with State authorities.

As part of the programme, a high-level meeting will be held with the Chief Secretary of Odisha and senior State Government officials. The discussions will focus on human rights concerns in the State. The Commission will also review issues related to the deaths caused by snake bites due to the absence of timely medical support, and recurring floods that have affected people in districts like Bhadrak and Kendrapada.

The Camp Sitting will conclude with an interaction session involving the Commission, human rights defenders, civil society activists and members of the media. This concluding session aims to foster dialogue, encourage transparency and strengthen collaborative efforts to uphold and protect human rights across Odisha.



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
