The NIPUN Week initiative is a significant step toward strengthening students’ foundational literacy and numeracy skills, preparing them for lifelong learning. Since its launch, the program has increased children’s interest in learning. Play-based methods have helped them grasp mathematical concepts such as counting, addition, and subtraction with ease, while storytelling and word games have improved their language and comprehension abilities. Students are becoming more attentive towards studies, with noticeable growth in confidence.

Hon’ble Chief Minister Shri Mohan Charan Majhi launched the “NIPUN Odisha” Mission on September 5, 2024. The mission aims to ensure that every child in the state between the ages of 3 and 8 attains foundational skills in reading, writing, and arithmetic at the primary level.
