

EMRS Mahasingi to Represent Odisha at Zonal-Level Youth Parliament Competition

Bhubaneswar, June 16: In a significant achievement for Odisha, Eklavya Model Residential School (EMRS), Mahasingi in Kandhamal district has qualified for the Zonal-Level Youth Parliament Competition (Zone III), which will be held at EMRS Ozili in Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh.
