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**THREE CONVICTIONS IN A DAY**

**TODAY, ODISHA VIGILANCE SECURES CONVICTION OF THREE GOVT. FUNCTIONARIES IN THREE VIGILANCE (DA & CORRUPTION) CASES.**

- I) SRI KALAYANIPURI GANDHI CHAUDHURY, FORMER EXECUTIVE ENGINEER, HYDRO ELECTRIC PROJECT INVESTIGATION DIVISION, JAYAPUR, KORAPUT CONVICTED IN DA CASE.**

Today i.e. on 30.06.2026, Sri Kalayanipuri Gandhi Chaudhury, Former Executive Engineer, Hydro Electric Project Investigation Division, Jayapur, Koraput (Retired), who was charge sheeted by Odisha Vigilance in a case U/s 13(2) r/w 13(1)(e) of PC Act, 1988/109 IPC for **possessing disproportionate assets (DA)**, was convicted by Hon'ble Special Judge, Special Court, Vigilance, Bhubaneswar and **sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 3 years and to pay fine of Rs.1,00,000/-.**

**Odisha Vigilance will now move the competent authority for stoppage of pension of Sri Kalayanipuri Gandhi Chaudhury, Former Executive Engineer, Hydro Electric Project Investigation Division, Jayapur, Koraput (Retired) following his conviction.**

Sri Sarbeswar Sahoo, Ex-Inspector, Vigilance, Cell Division had investigated the case and Sri Girija Patnaik, Spl. PP and Sri Chandrakant Das, PP, Vigilance, Bhubaneswar jointly conducted the case on behalf of the prosecution.

- II) SRI GANESWAR GIRI, FORMER DEVELOPMENT CLERK-CUM-STORE IN-CHARGE OF CHAMPUA BLOCK, KENDUJHAR CONVICTED IN VIGILANCE CORRUPTION CASE.**

Today i.e. on 30.06.2026, Sri Ganeswar Giri, Former Development Clerk-cum-Store In-charge of Champua Block, Kendujhar (Retired), who was charge sheeted by Odisha Vigilance U/s 13(2) r/w 13(1)(c) of PC Act,1988/409/468/471 IPC, for misappropriation of Govt. funds of Champua Block during the period from 2007-08 to 2010-11 by manipulating cement stock register of the Block, was convicted by Hon'ble Special Judge, Vigilance, Kendujhar and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 2 years and to pay fine Rs.10,000/-.

Odisha Vigilance will now move the competent authority for stoppage of pension of Sri Ganeswar Giri, Former Development Clerk-cum-Store In-charge of Champua Block, Kendujhar (Retired) following his conviction.

Sri H.K. Majhi, Ex-DSP, Vigilance, Baleshwar Division had investigated the case and Sri Debadutta Biswal & Sri Biswajit Kumar, Spl. PPs, Vigilance, Kendujhar jointly conducted the case on behalf of the prosecution.

### **III) SRI RAMESH CHANDRA MISHRA, FORMER RI, O/O SPL. LAND ACQUISITION OFFICER, LSIP, BALANGIR CONVICTED IN VIGILANCE CORRUPTION CASE.**

Today i.e. on 30.06.2026, Sri Ramesh Chandra Mishra, Former RI, office of Spl. Land Acquisition Officer, LSIP, Balangir (Retired), who was charge sheeted by Odisha Vigilance U/s 13(2) r/w 13(1)(c)(d) of PC Act,1988/419/420/468/471/477-A/120-B IPC, for misappropriation of Govt. funds by abuse of official position and adopting faulty official procedure in allowing land compensation amount in favour of an ingenuine person, was convicted by Hon'ble Special Judge, Vigilance, Balangir and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 3 years and to pay fine Rs.10,000/-.

Odisha Vigilance will now move the competent authority for stoppage of pension of Sri Ramesh Chandra Mishra, Former RI, office of Spl. Land Acquisition Officer, LSIP, Balangir (Retired) following his conviction.

Sri R.N. Patra, Ex-Inspector, Vigilance, Sambalpur Division had investigated the case and Sri Jayakrishna Sahu and Sri Swarup Ranjan Rath, Spl. PPs, Vigilance, Balangir jointly conducted the case on behalf of the prosecution.
